- To generously steward all that God entrusts to me—truth, time, talent and treasure.

In these ways I will grow as a disciple of Christ, and seek to make disciples who will carry the message of the gospel to this community and to the ends of the earth.

In addition, I will support the ministry and witness of Fellowship locally and globally by...

- Regular participation in weekly worship services—both to worship and serve in this community of faith.
- Practicing the ordinances Jesus gave to His church: Being baptized as a public profession of personal faith in Christ and regularly remember and proclaim the life and work of Jesus through the Lord's Supper.
- Submitting to the leadership of the church (elders), who are submitted to Christ as the Head of His church.
- Following biblical guidelines for church discipline, restoration, and conflict resolution.
- Striving for unity in the body through brotherly love, confession of sin, embracing our mutual brokenness, and living out the New Testament "one another" commands in grace-filled humility.
- Refusing to gossip and choosing instead to communicate in truth and love.

In the event that I leave Fellowship, I will endeavor to join to another community of faith to live out similar commitments made here, for the good of my soul, the body of Christ, and God's great glory. I will also seek to make this transition known to the appropriate church leadership.
